

Instructions:

1. Create a food web with these organisms by **cutting out the boxes and gluing them onto another page OR writing it on a separate page.**
2. Make sure you include arrows that show which organism is eating what. Remember the arrow means "is eaten by." So "*worm--->bird*" means **the worm is eaten by the bird.** Be careful not to mix it up with "*worm←-bird*" which means the **bird is eaten by the worm.**

<p style="text-align: center;">Algae</p> <p>Gets energy from photosynthesis. It is eaten by krill, algae, and fish.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Birds</p> <p>Eats fish and krill. Is eaten by seals and killer whales</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Blue Whale</p> <p>Eats krill and algae. Young blue whales are eaten by killer whales.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Fish</p> <p>Eat Krill and algae. Is eaten by killer whales, seals, and birds.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Killer whales</p> <p>Eats birds, young blue whales, seals, and fish. They have no predators.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Krill</p> <p>Eats algae. Is eaten by blue whale, fish, and birds.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bacteria</p> <p>All organisms are eventually consumed by bacteria.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Seals</p> <p>Eat fish and birds. Is eaten killer whales.</p>
